WHEREAS

- A. The Parties entered into the Settlement Agreement on or about 3 May 2018.
- B. The Parties wish to amend the Settlement Agreement, as set out in this Addendum.

IT IS AGREED AS FOLLOWS:

1. DEFINITIONS AND INTERPRETATION

1.1 Definitions

For the purposes of this Addendum and the preamble above, unless the context requires otherwise:

- 1.1.1 Addendum means this addendum and the schedules which form part of it;
- 1.1.2 Parties means the parties to this Addendum, and Party means any one of them as the context may require;
- Settlement Agreement means the agreement titled "Gold Mineworkers' Class Action Settlement Agreement", including all schedules thereto, entered into on or about 3 May 2018 between the Parties; and
- 1.1.2 Addendum Effective Date means the last date on which this Addendum is signed by or on behalf of the Parties.

1.2 Interpretation

- 1.2.1 Capitalized words and expressions in this Addendum, but not defined in clause 1.1 shall have the meanings given to them in Schedule 4 of the Settlement Agreement.
- 1.2.2 Unless expressly provided to the contrary or inconsistent with the context, a reference in this Addendum to:
- this **Addendum** or any other agreement, document or instrument shall be construed as a reference to this Addendum or that other agreement, document or instrument as amended, varied, novated or substituted from time to time;
- 1.2.2.2 a clause, sub-clause or Schedules is to a clause, sub-clause or schedules of or to this Addendum;
- a person includes any natural person, estate, firm, company, corporation, body corporate, juristic person, unincorporated association, government, state or agency of a state or any association, trust, partnership, syndicate, consortium, joint venture, charity or other entity (whether or not having separate legal personality);
- 1.2.2.4 any one gender, whether masculine, feminine or neuter, includes the other two;
- 1.2.2.5 the singular includes the plural and vice versa;
- 1.2.2.6 a word or expression given a particular meaning includes cognate words or expressions;

- 1.2.2.7 the words including, include or in particular followed by specific examples shall be construed by way of example or emphasis only and shall not be construed, nor shall it to take effect, as limiting the generality of any preceding words, and the eiusdem generis rule shall not to be applied in the interpretation of such specific examples or general words; and
- 1.2.2.8 the words other or otherwise shall not be construed eiusdem generis with any foregoing words where a wider construction is possible.
- 1.2.3 All the headings and sub-headings in this Addendum are for convenience and reference only and shall be ignored for the purposes of interpreting it.
- No rule of construction may be applied to the disadvantage of a Party because that Party was responsible for or participated in the preparation of this Addendum or any part of it.

2. AMENDMENTS

By its signature to this Addendum, each Party agrees that the Settlement Agreement be and is hereby amended, with effect from the Addendum Effective Date by the deletion of:

- 2.1 clause 1.1.68 in Schedule 4 of the Settlement Agreement and its replacement with the following new clause 1.1.68:
 - "1.1.68 Risk Work means the following:
 - 1.1.68.1 risk work as defined in ODMWA as at the Addendum Effective Date; or
 - 1.1.68.2 all or any of the following work: (i) work in the underground workings of a gold mine; (ii) work in a laundry where clothing of underground mineworkers is washed; (iii) work on a slimes dam of a gold mine; (iv) work in an assay laboratory of a gold mine where the composition of gold bearing ore is analysed, and where the mass of respirable dust from personal sampling is determined; (v) work in a metallurgical plant of a gold mine, including crushing, milling, transporting and smelting of ore; and (vi) work at conveyor belt operations which are undertaken to convey broken rock from the underground operations of a gold mine to surface."
- 2.2 Schedule 3 of the Settlement Agreement in its entirety and its replacement with a new Schedule 3, attached hereto, marked "A";
- 2.3 Schedule 7 of the Settlement Agreement in its entirety and its replacement with a new Schedule 7, attached hereto, marked "B";
- 2.4 Schedule 8 of the Settlement Agreement in its entirety and its replacement with a new Schedule 8, attached hereto, marked "C"; and
- 2.5 Schedule 9 of the Settlement Agreement in its entirety and its replacement with a new Schedule 9, attached hereto, marked "D".

3. CONTINUATION OF THE SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

Save as amended under clause 2 all the terms and conditions of the Settlement Agreement shall continue in full force and effect.

4. COUNTERPARTS

This Addendum may be executed in any number of counterparts, each counterpart when read together shall constitute one and the same document.

SCHEDULE 3

OPT OUT NOTICE

If you are currently or have been a GOLD MINEWORKER in South Africa, at any time after 12 March 1965, and have been exposed to silica dust or you have contracted silicosis or tuberculosis ("TB") OR you are A DEPENDANT (for example, the wife, child or life partner) of such a gold mineworker who has since passed away, PLEASE READ THIS NOTICE CAREFULLY AS IT MAY AFFECT YOUR RIGHTS.

On 3 May 2018, six mining companies, African Rainbow Minerals, Anglo American SA, AngloGold Ashanti, Gold Fields, Harmony, Sibanye-Stillwater and some of their affiliates, as well as class representatives and mineworkers' lawyers reached a settlement in the silicosis and TB class action litigation. The settlement has been approved by the High Court.

You may be eligible to claim compensation if you are currently or have been a GOLD MINEWORKER in South Africa at any time after 12 March 1965, and have been exposed to silica dust or you have contracted silicosis or TB or you are a dependant of a mineworker who worked at the affected gold mines during this time and has since passed away.

THE SETTLEMENT

Six companies - African Rainbow Minerals, Anglo American SA, AngloGold Ashanti, Gold Fields, Harmony and Sibanye-Stillwater and some of their affiliates ("the participating gold mining companies") have reached a conditional settlement to pay compensation to eligible gold mineworkers and the dependants of such mineworkers who have passed away. The proposed settlement will settle the claims against the participating gold mining companies arising from the class action that was initiated before the High Court for:

- the harm and loss suffered by mineworkers who contracted silicosis and/or TB during their work on certain gold mines in South Africa, and
- the harm and loss suffered by the dependants of mineworkers who died of these diseases.

The settlement was approved by the High Court in Johannesburg on [INSERT DATE].

WHO IS INCLUDED IN THE SETTLEMENT?

You are a class member, and will be included in the settlement, if you meet all the requirements of any of the four classes:

	A STATE OF THE STA
Class 1:	All people: 1. who as at the date when the settlement agreement comes into force, have undertaken risk work. In terms of the settlement agreement, risk work means "risk work" as defined in the Occupational Diseases in Mines and Works Act, 1973 or any of the following work: (i) work in the underground workings of a gold mine; (ii) work in a laundry where clothing of underground mineworkers is washed; (iii) work on a slimes dam of a gold mine; (iv) work in an assay laboratory of a gold mine where the composition of gold bearing ore is analysed, and where the mass of respirable dust from personal sampling is determined; (v) work in a metallurgical plant of a gold mine, including crushing, milling, transporting and smelting of ore; and
	from personal sampling is determined;
	who on or before the date when the settlement agreement comes into force, have contracted silicosis or have been exposed to silica dust;

 who undertake or have undertaken risk work on one or more of the mines listed in Annexure A of this notice after 12 March 1965; and
 who did not settle their claims in previously finalised settlements with Anglo American South Africa Limited and AngloGold Ashanti Limited on 14 March 2016 and Anglo American South Africa Limited on 19 September 2013, respectively.
The dependants of any of the persons in Class 1 above who are deceased as at the date when the settlement agreement comes into force.
All people:
 who as at the date when the settlement agreement comes into force have undertaken risk work;
who on, before or after the date when the settlement agreement will come into force have contracted Tuberculosis; and
 who undertake or have undertaken risk work, after 12 March 1965, on one or more of the gold mines listed in Annexure A of this notice.
The dependants of any of the persons in Class 3 above who are deceased as at the date when the settlement agreement comes into force.

WHAT IS THE EFFECT OF THE SETTLEMENT?

The settlement is not yet in force because some of its conditions have not yet been met. If the conditions are met, the participating gold mining companies will establish a fund, called the TSHIAMISO TRUST.

If the settlement agreement comes into force:

- The participating gold mining companies will pay agreed contributions to the Tshiamiso Trust and the process of paying compensation can start.
- All class members can <u>submit a claim to the Tshlamiso Trust</u> for monetary compensation, except for those class members who opt out of the settlement.
- Details of how to submit a claim to the Tshiamiso Trust will be published in the media and on the website
 www.silicosissettlement.co.za.
- The Tshiamiso Trust will pay compensation to <u>ellalble claimants</u>. An eligible claimant is a person who is a
 member of any of the classes and who meets the requirements of the Tshiamiso Trust to receive monetary
 compensation.
- Class members must submit a completed claim form to the Tshiamlso Trust and may have to undergo a medical examination to determine if they are eligible claimants.

Once the settlement agreement is in force, eligible claimants will be entitled to receive a once-off payment of between R10 000 and R250 000, depending on the nature and seriousness of the disease. In certain exceptional circumstances, this amount may be increased to up to R500 000.

YOU DO NOT NEED TO PAY ANYONE TO ASSIST YOU TO MAKE YOUR CLAIM

WHAT MUST I DO TO REMAIN PART OF THE SETTLEMENT?

IF YOU ARE A CLASS MEMBER AND YOU WISH TO BE PART OF THE SETTLEMENT, NO ACTION IS NECESSARY AT THIS TIME.

While you do not have to do anything to participate in the settlement, if you wish to send your contact details expressing your interest in participating, you may do so by completing an information form or registering your interest at this website www.silicosissettlement.co.za.

OPTING OUT OF THE SETTLEMENT

IF YOU ARE A CLASS MEMBER, THE SETTLEMENT IS AUTOMATICALLY BINDING ON YOU UNLESS YOU TAKE STEPS TO OPT OUT. If you do not want to be part of the settlement, or you want the right to pursue your claim individually in court, then you must take steps to opt out of the settlement.

To opt out of the settlement, you must COMPLETE AND SIGN EITHER FORM A; FORM B; OR FORM C (WHICHEVER APPLIES TO YOU) AND DELIVER IT, TOGETHER WITH THE REQUIRED SUPPORTING DOCUMENTS, TO THE INDEPENDENT AUDITOR [INSERT NAME] before [INSERT DATE – 60 days from last date of notice].

The form must be signed before a commissioner of auths. Every police station in South Africa has a commissioner of auths.

If you are currently or have been a GOLD MINEWORKER in South Africa, at any time after 12 March 1965, and have been exposed to silica dust or you have contracted silicosis or tuberculosis ("TB") <u>OR</u> you are A DEPENDANT (e.g., the wife, child or life partner) of such a gold mineworker who has since passed away, PLEASE READ THIS NOTICE CAREFULLY AS IT MAY AFFECT YOUR RIGHTS.

If you have some other interest in the proposed settlement you should also read this notice.

THE PROPOSED SETTLEMENT

Six companies, African Rainbow Minerals, Anglo American SA, Anglo Gold Ashanti, Gold Fields, Harmony, Sibanye-Stillwater and some of their affiliates ("the participating gold mining companies") have reached a conditional settlement to pay compensation to eligible gold mineworkers and the dependants of such mineworkers who have passed away. The proposed settlement will settle the claims against the participating gold mining companies arising from the class action that was initiated before the High Court for:

- the harm and loss suffered by mineworkers who contracted silicosis and/or TB during their work on certain gold mines in South Africa, and
- the harm and loss suffered by the dependants of mineworkers who died of these diseases.

The proposed settlement is subject to certain conditions and must be approved by the High Court before it comes into force.

If the settlement is approved and all its other conditions are met, a Trust called the Tshiamiso Trust will be established and will exist for a minimum of 13 years.

<u>All class members</u>, except those that choose to opt out of the settlement, will be entitled to <u>submit a claim to the Tshlamiso Trust</u> for monetary compensation.

Ellaible claimants will be entitled to receive a once-off payment of between R10 000 and R250 000, depending on the nature and seriousness of the disease. In certain exceptional circumstances, this amount may be increased to up to R500 000. An eligible claimant is a person who is a member of any of the classes and who meets the requirements of the Ishiamiso Trust to receive monetary compensation.

The participating gold mining companies are also required to pay the class lawyers a set amount for legal costs and to pay for the administration of the Tshiamiso Trust.

WHO IS A CLASS MEMBER?

You are a class member, and will be entitled to submit a claim to the Tshiamiso Trust, if you meet <u>all</u> the requirements of any of the four classes:

Class 1:	All people:
