UPDATE: SIBANYE-STILLWATER GOLD WAGE NEGOTIATIONS TO CONTINUE ON 18 NOVEMBER

Johannesburg, 11 November 2021. Sibanye-Stillwater continued to engage with the representative unions at its SA gold operations, AMCU, the NUM, Solidarity and UASA under the auspices of the Commission for Conciliation, Mediation and Arbitration (CCMA) regarding wage negotiations at its gold operations today.

Sibanye-Stillwater will continue to engage with union representatives with the aim of reaching an agreement that is fair, will benefit employees and ensure the long-term sustainability of its gold operations. The stability of these operations is critical in the interest of supporting the livelihoods of gold employees, contributing to communities and the national fiscus and the many stakeholders that depend on these operations.
